

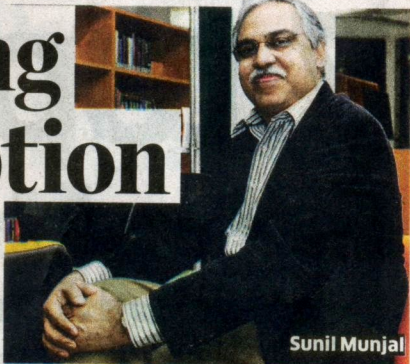
# Talking disruption
